1.	<p><u>NOMINATE CHAIR</u></p> <p>Margaret was nominated as Chair for the meeting.</p>	
2.	<p><u>APOLOGIES</u></p> <p>Apologies were given by those indicated above</p>	
3.	<p><u>UPDATE ON COMMUNITY HUB</u></p> <p>Things aren't progressing as quickly as hoped. Due to the fact that the works being done have been kindly donated and getting scaffolders, roofers and renderers all together has been hard. 1 weeks worth of rendering works will be done at the beginning of August.</p> <p>On the positive side, all toilets and hand basins are done. The building is essentially 'usable' but it's not finished. The front entrance is not in use but the building is working. Chatterbox café is still working towards its August opening. The footing for the canopy was done this afternoon and we are hopeful that the canopy is on track.</p> <p>The Management Committee was transformed into the St Martins Walk around. It is time to reinstate these meetings, they will be probably be held</p>	

	<p>every other month. ABL is keen to continue with the places they hold on the committee until this is reviewed.</p> <p>It is suggested that the Co-ordinator will be at St Martins a few hours per week as part of the ABL presence in the area.</p>	
4.	<p><u>UPDATE ON DERBY ADULT LEARNING SERVICES</u></p> <p>The DALs educational proposal was discussed at a meeting in June. It was a long meeting, a lot of ideas were discussed. There was the idea of Historical Archive reflecting on the community. There was a discussion on how they can go about it such as, a multimedia type platform, a summer school to introduce people to different interests and maybe an open day for creative learning. Simon put together a summary of ideas and asked for people to think about what they would want and to get back to him. Simon is currently waiting for the ideas back and there will be another meeting reflecting this.</p> <p>This has the potential to involve the local community, and we could look at a way to use the new Plan with the launch of this project. Will ask Jane to be in touch with Simon so that in autumn the Plan will align with Simons project.</p> <p>If what is agreed requires extra funding then it depends on how much and if there's an under-spend that will cover it, if the money is there then it can be used. Simon will put together his plan.</p>	Jane/Simon
