3.	<p><u>ST MARTINS UPDATE</u></p> <p>Mairi and Carl provided the Board with a good update regarding further progress since the latest ABL grant had been processed. The weather has continued to create some challenges however there is a clear project plan in place between now and mid/late July that includes completion of heating installation, tarmacking, decorating and other essential works. The Project Management Team are working busily in the background bringing trades and suppliers together to hit critical dates.</p> <p>The centre remains open for much of the regular users and Derby Homes have an event booked in for early June.</p> <p>The next site visit so will be held on Friday 20th April (3rd Friday of every month) and people are being encouraged not to try and visit it at any other times as the centre does actually remain an active building site.</p>

5.	<p><u>MINUTES OF LAST MEETING</u></p> <p>All present agreed that the minutes were a true reflection of the last meeting and all actions had be achieved or remained in progress.</p>	
6.	<p><u>ANY OTHER BUSINESS</u></p> <p>A group of ABL girls, staff and volunteers have just concluded a two week project with the University of Derby that exposed them all to arts and heritage. They all received a certificate and their work will form part of the Universities FORMAT exhibition</p> <p>Enthusiasm hosted a ministerial visit and a home office visit this week in response to the work they do with disadvantaged and at risk young people. These visits coincided with the launch of the Home Offices #KnifeFree campaign. A number of people from Allenton who're involved with Enthusiasm as staff, volunteers and young people were interviewed by local, regional and national press</p> <p>Nacro Osmaston will close shortly. Following a meeting between Edith, Heather, Margaret and Alan from Nacro – Nacro confirmed that they intend to fully deliver the ABL funded family project; although they may require some negotiation in order to accommodate logistics. Nacro explained that they envisage issues delivering the ABL funded healthy cooking/eating project and are happy to work with the partnership to identify suitable solutions.</p>
