MONITORING REPORT

Priority 2

October - December

Current work undertaken:

- Direct work with Mum, Stepdad and 4 children to encourage positive family time together within a newly formed family unit.
- Direct work with mum and 2 young children to build positive relationships to alleviate stress and arguments in family home.
- Support to family with issues of children not sleeping, support with bedtime routines.
- Support to mum new in the community, with Urdu as first language. Support to link into community activities.
- Support to family with behaviour management issues with child's recent diagnosed with diabetes.
- We have held 6 group sessions for parents who preferred to attend a group rather than receive support at home. This also enabled them to meet other parents and share their experiences in a group setting, which they found very useful as many parents felt quite isolated and

realised that other parents have very similar problems with their children's behaviour.
